# IN THE GOSPEL TODAY

Can you work out what it says?

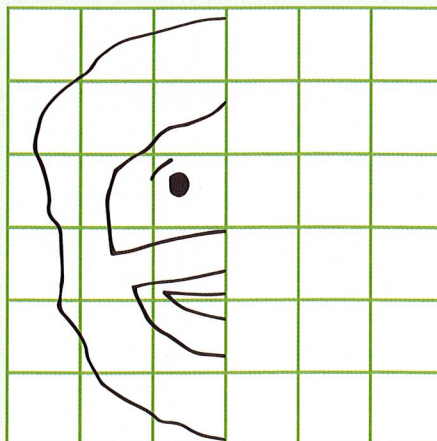
