They are not so lovely as the living flower. Without God's love there is something missing. Trusting God fills up that gap and makes us as lovely as the whole flower. It makes us properly alive.

Have you ever noticed how you feel, if you expect something bad to happen, and then it doesn't happen? Maybe you think your parents are going to be very cross about something, but then they aren't cross at all. Or maybe you knocked something over, and you thought it would break, but it landed safely?

Just when you think something bad will happen, you feel all scared and upset. But when it's OK, you feel great. You feel much better than usual. Everything seems nicer and happier than usual. Have you noticed that? You feel more alive, more special, because something bad has not happened. There was a man called Anthony who liked to go climbing. Anthony had an accident on a mountain. He fell off a high place and got stuck half-way down. He couldn't move, and he thought he would die, but he was rescued.

The next day, all the world looked wonderful! The mountains seemed more beautiful than ever, the people seemed kinder, and even the water tasted better. Anthony realised that he felt much more alive than usual, and that it was a wonderful feeling. He thanked God that he was alive. He wished he could feel that way every day. But the feeling wore off, and Anthony felt ordinary again. Anthony thought and thought how to get that wonderful feeling back. He read books and he asked other people, but no one had the answer. Then he realised that he had had the answer all the time. He was alive every day, but until he nearly fell off the mountain he just hadn't noticed how good that was.
